

## Copper Coil Directions

- Cut wire into 2-yard lengths- they have to be 2 yard lengths in order to work. They won't work if they are only 1-yard length.
- Wrap each piece around the bottom of the white cup where the line is. This is the size the copper coil needs to be.
- Secure the coil by wrapping the tail ends of the copper around the coil. Please make sure that the ends are secured and wrapped around only one part of the copper coil and not in two different places. See diagram below.
- Place 6 copper coils into one small ziplock bag.
- Place 20 small Ziploc bags per 1 large Ziploc bag

Coils need to be finished and returned to Kintea at Seattle Audubon by March 8<sup>th</sup>.
